If you are facing a crisis whether you are working or not and because of low income, job loss, accidents, injury or sickness, bereavement, benefit delays or debt you can get help if you need food for yourself or your family.

Once you have your voucher or when your text referral has been sent through to the Distribution Centre of your choice, you can go along and collect enough food for up to 5 days along with toiletries, household cleaning products and pet food. Please take along some ID with your address on and some shopping bags when you attend.



School holidays can often be a challenge, so don't forget to ask for vouchers before we break up – we will aim to give you enough support to get you through the holiday periods by providing post-dated vouchers where possible.
