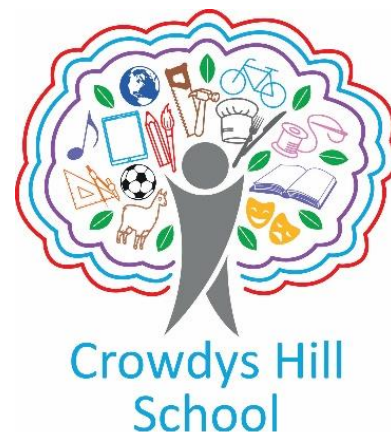

Dear Parents/Carers

Rewards

We have recently reviewed our rewards system at Crowdys Hill School. We asked staff and school council representatives for their views on what worked. As a result, we have finalised the following reward systems, some of which we already had, and some new ones. Your child may talk about these, or bring home certificates.

In class rewards for positive behaviour, attitude or achievements


- Primary – Dojos and class rewards. Pupils can receive small items using their Dojo points
- Key Stage 3 (years 7,8,9) – Dojos, Class Dojos. Pupils can 'buy' items with their Dojo points.
- Key Stage 4 and 5 (years 10,11,12,13,14) – VIP Nomination rewarded fortnightly. Pupils have a treat, such as tea and cakes.

Whole school rewards

- Praise Postcards from subject teachers for exceptional effort or achievement
- Headteacher certificate. Only 4 per week across the school, awarded for producing great work, or trying something difficult or new.
- House Points for group events. Each pupil is in a house group, Coate, Lydiard or Stanton. Whenever they take part in house competitions, they can win points for their house. The winning house has a free trip at the end of the school year.
- End of year subject trophies and medals awarded to one pupil for each subject, for consistent excellence in that subject, e.g. Maths, English, Music
- Attendance certificates sent out each term for 95% attendance or above.
